## EQUIPMENT

All shooting equipment must comply with current ISSF Shooting Rules. Equipment control consultation will be provided before each event

## AMMUNITION

USA Shooting and ISSF require 24g cartridges, no exceptions (see ISSF Shotgun Rules 9.4.3.1). Failure to comply will result in disqualification from the match (see ISSF Shotgun Rules 9.4.3.2).

Winchester AA ammunition will be available during the match at \$115.00 + tax.



# 2023 JUNIOR NATIONAL TEAM SELECTION

## **ATHLETES' CLOTHING**

Refer to ISSF Shotgun Rules 9.13.1. USA Shooting has exceptions to this rule, and permitted items of clothing include blue jeans, and camouflage. No clothing should have holes or offensive writing.

## **CHECK-IN**

All competitors will need to check-in with the event staff at HCSSC by noon on the PET Day. If you cannot make it by this time, make sure to send a representative to check in for you.

## **COMPETITOR MEETING**

A mandatory meeting will be held promptly 30 Minutes before PET day for both Trap & Skeet. Rules of the range, athlete flanking responsibilities and overall match information will be provided at this meeting that will take place in front of the clubhouse.

## **EQUIPMENT**

All shooting equipment must comply with current ISSF Shooting Rules. Equipment control consultation will be provided before each event.

## **START TIMES**

Start times will be announced by the match director and posted at the Match

## **OFFICIATING**

Juries will be appointed and convened as required to resolve any protest. Decisions of the jury will be final.

## **PROTESTS**

A fee of \$25.00 must accompany any protest. Forms are available on ISSF Website

## **OPEN PRACTICE**

**Open training will be available for Trap and Skeet**

### FAQ

Q. Once I make the Team will all my expenses be Covered?

A. No all expenses including travel to the World events will be contingent on Budget and Available funds.

Q. Will shooting the Team Selection Match qualify me to shoot JO National Championships?

A. Yes it will

Q. If I make the Team will my parents be able to travel with me?

A. Yes However, your parents will be responsible for all their travel and travel arrangements thereof. USA Shooting will facilitate Travel, Lodging, Gun Permits, and ground transportation for Team members only. Team members will be expected to travel with the Team.

Q. Can I shoot reloads at the Team Selection Match

A. No, New compliant ammunition is required at the Team Selection Match

Q. Will coaching be allowed on the line during training?

A. Yes coaching is allowed on the field of play during all practice times.

Q. Will coaching be allowed on the line during the match?

A. No, Coaches will not be allowed on the field of play during match rounds, however nonverbal coaching from behind the field of play is allowed. Work on those hand signals!

Q. Will there be folks there to help answer questions on equipment and procedures.

A. Yes, Staff and Jury members will be available during PET and the match to help answer questions and educate participants on rules and procedures.

Q. How many athletes are eligible to make the National Junior Team

A. The top four (4) competitors in both Trap and Skeet and Men and Women will be placed on the National Junior Team. Top 3 Earn Travel Positions 4<sup>th</sup> Named Alternate
