USA SHOOTING 2025 ISSF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS (WCH) SELECTION MATCH FREE, STANDARD AND CENTER FIRE PISTOL August 22, 23 & 24, 2025

LOCATION: Deer Creek Shooting Center, 1142 Deer Creek, Missoula, Montana 59802

GENERAL INFORMATION: This USA Shooting (USAS) pistol competition consists of squadded outdoor matches, with no finals, fired on paper targets. These matches are open to all.

INFORMATION FOR THOSE WISHING TO REPRESENT THE USA IN THE WCH: These matches serve to select the Free, Standard and Center Fire Teams to represent the USA in the ISSF World Pistol Championships in Cairo, Egypt in November, 2025. If you wish to be considered, register on the U.S.A. Shooting website. Membership in USAS is mandatory, with current Safe Sport and Background Checks. You must possess a U.S. Passport with an expiration date less than nine months. EVENTS:

FREE PISTOL: (60 shots, fired on paper stationary targets at 50 meters in one hour and 45 minutes.)

STANDARD PISTOL: (60 total shots, all fired on turning targets at 25 meters.) Twenty shots in Slow Fire (five rounds in 2.5 minutes), 20 shots Timed (five rounds in 20 seconds), and 20 shots Rapid (five rounds in 10 seconds).

CENTER FIRE PISTOL: 60 total shots, all fired at 25 meters, in two parts: Precision and Rapid. Precision is thirty shots, fired in six iterations of 5 rounds each, within five minutes. Rapid consists of thirty shots, fired in six iterations of five rounds in seven second intervals and three seconds of firing time.

*25m SPORT PISTOL: For Women and Junior Men only (classified as junior until December 31st in the year in which they turn 21). Course of fire is the same as Center Fire Pistol. Competitors may shoot either Center Fire or Sport, but not both.

EQUIPMENT CHECK: Guns, glasses, and shoes will be checked prior to competition.

SAFETY: Guns must be in cases. Only open cases when preparation period begins, in the assigned dry fire area, or during equipment checks.

*Sport Pistol is not an event included in this World Championship Team selection process. This 22-only event is added to increase awareness of this Olympic sport, and to provide youth an opportunity to compete. Priority for squadding goes to Center Fire competitors.
